RESOLUTION 2017-323

Authorizing a Cooperative Community Development Activities Agreement with the County of Middlesex

WHEREAS, the Township of South Brunswick and the County of Middlesex entered into an agreement on July 15, 1993, for the cooperative means of conducting certain community development activities utilizing Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and HOME Investment Partnerships funds from the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, which agreement has been renewed for successive terms; and

WHEREAS, the County of Middlesex has proposed a new Agreement in place of making amendments to the existing Agreement, which new Agreement shall be for the years 2018, 2019 and 2020, and carry an automatic renewal provision for successive years; and

WHEREAS, the County and the Township agree that it is in the best interests of the residents of South Brunswick to enter into the new Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Law has reviewed the new Agreement and approves of same as to form;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED on this 26th day of September, 2017, by the Township Council of the Township of South Brunswick, County of Middlesex, State of New Jersey, that:

1. The Mayor and Township Clerk shall be and are hereby authorized to execute a Cooperative Community Development Activities Agreement with the County of Middlesex for the cooperative means of conducting certain community development activities utilizing Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and HOME Investment Partnerships funds for the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, to cover the initial term of 2018-2020, with automatic renewal for successive years.
2. A certified copy of this Resolution, along with three officially executed copies of the Agreement, be returned to the County of Middlesex, Public Housing Agency, Division of Housing, Community Development and Social Services.
3. A fully executed copy of the Agreement shall remain on file with the Township Clerk.
