

SHARED SERVICES AGREEMENT BETWEEN
THE COUNTY OF CUMBERLAND
AND
THE SENATOR WALTER RAND INSTITUTE

THIS AGREEMENT made as of the 24th day of May, 2016 **BY AND BETWEEN:**

COUNTY OF CUMBERLAND, a municipal corporation, 790 East Commerce Street, Bridgeton, New Jersey 08302 (hereinafter referred to in this Agreement as "County");

AND:

THE SENATOR WALTER RAND INSTITUTE, part of Rutgers University, whose address is 411 Cooper Street, Camden, New Jersey 08102 (hereinafter referred to in this Agreement as "WRI").

WITNESSETH THAT:

WHEREAS, The Senator Walter Rand Institute (WRI), part of Rutgers University, Camden, was selected by the New Jersey State Attorney General's Office to staff and provide technical assistance for juvenile delinquency prevention policy boards in select cities as part of the State's crime prevention initiative following the adoption of the Strategy for Safe Streets and Neighborhoods in New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, the cities of Bridgeton and Millville have expressed serious interest in

developing their own local planning efforts, not only to implement strategies to prevent today's youth from becoming tomorrow's crime issues, but to also reduce violent crime today; and

WHEREAS, the County of Cumberland has a tradition of providing financial assistance for said services; and

WHEREAS, the Finance Committee has recommended that the County provide funding in the amount of \$60,000.00 to WRI for the period July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2017 for providing juvenile delinquency prevention services; and

WHEREAS, the Uniform Shared Services and Consolidation Act (N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1 et seq.), provides that local units of government may enter into a contract for the joint provision of any service which either party to said agreement is empowered to render or perform within its own jurisdiction.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the terms and conditions hereinafter set forth, the parties agree as follows:

1. County shall appropriate the amount of **SIXTY THOUSAND (\$60,000.00) DOLLARS** to The Senator Walter Rand Institute for the cities of Bridgeton and Millville to continue to provide juvenile delinquency prevention services.
2. The term of this agreement shall be July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2017.
3. The parties to this agreement agree to abide by the regulations of P.L. 1975, Chapter 127, Affirmative Action as described in Schedule A, attached hereto and made a part hereof.
4. This agreement may be amended upon the written agreement of both parties. This agreement represents the entire agreement between the County and WRI and supersedes all prior negotiations, representations, or agreements, wither written or oral for this project.
5. The amount set forth in Paragraph 1 shall be disbursed to the cities of Millville and

Bridgeton in proportions to be determined by The Walter Rand Institute. The performance of services by the juvenile delinquency policy boards (or agency providing such services) by the cities of Millville and Bridgeton shall be performed in accordance with the Measurable Program Objectives set forth in Appendix A attached hereto and made a part hereof.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF and in consideration of the terms and conditions of this agreement, the parties hereunto set their hands and seals, intended to be legally bound.




