## ORDINANCE NO

## AN ORDINANCE TO VACATE A PORTION OF GREENWOOD AVENUE

WHEREAS, the Township of South Brunswick has or is about to enter into several agreements with the Trustees of Princeton University, the State of New Jersey and Wm. Flemer's Sons, Inc., for the transfer of certain property rights between the parties that will result in significant open space parcels being held by the Township and the State of New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, certain property located at Block 99, Lot 3.011 is to be donated to the State of New Jersey and the Township of South Brunswick jointly, for use as open space; and

WHEREAS, this property is encumbered by the right-of-way for Greenwood Avenue, a portion of which shall be converted to open space; and

WHEREAS, in order for this parcel to be dedicated to the State of New Jersey and the Township of South Brunswick jointly and maintained as open space, the right-of-way should be vacated so that clear title can pass when it is conveyed;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Township of South Brunswick, County of Middlesex, State of New Jersey that:

- I. A portion of the right-of-way for Greenwood Avenue situated in South Brunswick
  Township, County of Middlesex and State of New Jersey, which is more particularly
  and is hereby vacated, and all public rights therein extinguished, subject, however, to the

- II. South Brunswick Township, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:67-19, for itself, its successors and assigns, reserves unto itself the right to construct, install, build, operate, maintain, use, facilities, within the Vacated Property, which it may, at any time hereafter, deem necessary for the public health, safety, convenience and welfare.

III. South Brunswick Township further reserves unto itself the right to use, maintain, repair, replace and relocate all existing utilities owned or controlled by it located in, adjacent to, adoption of the addition of the reserves.

V. Adoption of this ordinance shall not impair or extinguish any easements granted by the Township, either alone or in combination with others, to the Trustees of Princeton University for Drainage, Driveway and/or Pedestrian Trail purposes.

VI. Once finally adopted, the Township Clerk shall send a certified copy of this Ordinance, together with a copy of the proof of publication thereof, to the Middlesex County Clerk, Register of Deeds and Mortecopy and to the New York.

Register of Deeds and Mortgages, and to the New Jersey Department of Transportation.

If any clause, sentence, paragraph, section or part of this ordinance or any other codes or to be invalid, such judgment shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, section or part rendered.

A portion of the right-of-way for Greenwood Avenue situated in South Brunswick Township, County of Middlesex and State of New Jersey, which is more particularly described in Exhibit A attached hereto and made a part hereof ("Vacated Property"), be and is hereby vacated, and all public rights therein extinguished, subject, however, to the reservations set forth below.

11. South Brunswick Township, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:67-19, for itself, its successors and assigns, reserves unto itself the right to construct, install, build, operate, maintain, use, repair, replace and relocate public utilities, including but not limited to cable television facilities, within the Vacated Property, which it may, at any time hereafter, deem necessary for the public health, safety, convenience and welfare. 111

South Brunswick Township further reserves unto itself the right to use, maintain, repair, replace and relocate all existing utilities owned or controlled by it located in, adjacent to,

upon or through said Vacated Property.

IV. Adoption of this ordinance shall not affect the balance of Greenwood Avenue, which shall remain a public street owned and maintained by South Brunswick Township.

Adoption of this ordinance shall not impair or extinguish any easements granted by the V. Township, either alone or in combination with others, to the Trustees of Princeton University for Drainage, Driveway and/or Pedestrian Trail purposes. VI.

Once finally adopted, the Township Clerk shall send a certified copy of this Ordinance, together with a copy of the proof of publication thereof, to the Middlesex County Clerk, Register of Deeds and Mortgages, and to the New Jersey Department of Transportation.

VII. If any clause, sentence, paragraph, section or part of this ordinance or any other codes or ordinances incorporated herein shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, section or part thereof directly involved in the controversy in which said judgment shall have been rendered. VIII.

This ordinance shall become effective twenty (20) days after its final passage.
