**AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF BRIDGETON
AND THE TOWNSHIP OF UPPER DEERFIELD FOR THE SHARED SERVICES OF A
JETTER/VAC TRUCK AND OPERATOR**

THIS AGREEMENT by and between the City of Bridgeton, a municipal Corporation having its offices at 181 East Commerce Street, Bridgeton, NJ 08302, and the Township of Upper Deerfield, a municipal Corporation having its offices located at 1325 State Highway 77, Seabrook, New Jersey, 08302, dated this 15th day of August, 2013 .

WHEREAS, the City of Bridgeton is desirous of providing, and the Township of Upper Deerfield is desirous of obtaining, the services of a jetter/vac truck and operator for the maintenance of Storm Drains and Sewer lines; and

WHEREAS, Shared Services Agreements are authorized pursuant to the Shared Services Act, N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1, et seq.; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bridgeton and the Township of Upper Deerfield have each, by resolution, authorized the entering into of this agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the terms, conditions, mutual benefits, and covenants hereinafter set forth, the City of Bridgeton and the Township of Upper Deerfield make this agreement.


1. The Township of Upper Deerfield shall occasionally request and retain the services of the City of Bridgeton for use of a jetter/vac truck and operator for the maintenance of Storm Drains and Sewer lines.
2. The Township of Upper Deerfield shall pay a fee of \$ 86.00 (eighty-six dollars) per hour for the use of aforementioned services, to the City of Bridgeton. This payment shall be made within 30 days of receipt of a monthly invoice from the City of Bridgeton. This Agreement shall continue from year

to year unless either party to the agreement provides 30 days notice, in writing, to the other of its intent to discontinue the services provided hereunder.


3. This agreement shall constitute the entire agreement between the City of Bridgeton and Township of Upper Deerfield and shall supersede any and all prior agreements and understandings. Any amendments to alter this agreement must be in writing and must be executed by the City of Bridgeton and Township of Upper Deerfield to become effective.
4. This Agreement shall be construed in accordance with Laws of the State of New Jersey and it is intended that this agreement shall be entirely performed within the State of New Jersey.

5. If any provision of this Agreement shall be determined by a court of competent jurisdiction to be null, void, *ultra vires*, or otherwise in contravention of law, the remainder of this Agreement not so determined shall remain in full force and effect.



WHEREAS, the Sewer and Water Utility can provide the service; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Bridgeton is desirous of entering into a shared services agreement with the Township of Upper Deerfield to provide services with the Jetter/Vac Truck and Operator to the Township of Upper Deerfield; and





BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Upper Deerfield that the Mayor and Clerk be and are hereby authorized to execute the aforesaid agreement on behalf of the Township of Upper Deerfield; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Upper Deerfield that the agreement shall be deemed to be effective commencing on August 15, 2013.


