**A RESOLUTION EXTENDING SHARED SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH THE
TOWNSHIP OF HAMILTON FOR USE OF HAMILTON TOWNSHIP ECOLOGICAL
CENTER**

WHEREAS, the “Uniform Shared Services and Consolidation Act”, N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1 et seq. (the “Act”), authorizes local units of this State to enter into an agreement with any other local unit or units to provide or receive any service that each local unit participating in the agreement is empowered to provide or receive in its own jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, Hamilton Township operates the Hamilton Township Ecological Facility located on Kuser Road in Hamilton Township (hereinafter “Ecological Facility”) for the collection and recycling of brush, tree stumps and leaves; and

WHEREAS, Hamilton Township has determined that it is desirable to offer certain services of the Ecological Facility to neighboring municipalities; and

WHEREAS, Robbinsville Township has determined that it is desirable to utilize certain services of the Ecological Facility; and

WHEREAS, in the spirit of cooperation, and in furtherance of the principles underlying the Act, Hamilton and Robbinsville have negotiated an Agreement for the provision of the shared services for use of the Ecological Facility; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Hamilton has agreed to provide said services to Robbinsville Township for an annual not to exceed amount of \$32,000.00, to be paid quarterly and at the end of the first year, the annual fee shall be adjusted based upon the actual volume of materials deposited at the Ecological Center; and

WHEREAS, such agreements are authorized pursuant to the Uniform Shared Services Consolidation Act, N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1 et. seq.; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has certified that funds are available for said purpose in account numbers 6-01-32-465-000-229 and 7-01-32-465-000-229; and

WHEREAS, on June 25, 2015, the Township council approved resolution 2015-186, which included nine (9) one-year options to extend the agreement; and

WHEREAS, Robbinsville Township has a desire to continue this agreement, and exercise its option to extend the agreement for an additional year, as it is the most convenient, and cost effective way of recycling of brush, tree stumps and leaves; and

WHEREAS, the Township Council has determined that this agreement is in the best interest of the Township of Robbinsville.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Council of the Township of Robbinsville, in the County of Mercer and State of New Jersey, that the Shared Services Agreement by and between the Township of Hamilton and the Township of Robbinsville for the provision of the collection and recycling of brush, tree stumps and leaves services be and is approved and the proper officials of the Township of Robbinsville are authorized to execute said agreement.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the agreement shall take effect upon the adoption of an appropriate resolution by the Township of Hamilton and the execution of agreement by the parties in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1, et seq.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution and agreement shall be forwarded to the Director of the Division of Local Government Services as per NJSA 40A:65-4 (3) b.
