

## UNIFORM SHARED SERVICES AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT, entered into as of the 1<sup>st</sup> day of September 2014 by and between:

THE OCEAN COUNTY UTILITIES AUTHORITY, a public body  
Politic and constituting a political subdivision of the State of New  
Jersey, having its principal offices at 501 Hickory Lane, P.O. Box P  
Bayville, New Jersey 08721

(hereinafter referred to as the "Authority")

AND

TOWNSHIP OF LONG BEACH, a body politic of the State of  
New Jersey, having its principal office in New Jersey

(hereinafter referred to as the "Township");

### WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, potassium permanganate is required to control the level of sulfites caused by the characteristics of the discharge by the Township to the Authority's system at the High Bar Harbor Sewer Pump Station (SPS-9); and

WHEREAS, the Township has reimbursed the Authority for the cost of potassium permanganate on an informal basis since 1996; and

WHEREAS, the Authority purchases potassium permanganate at public bid for its use; and

WHEREAS, the parties desired to enter into a formal agreement for this practice in the future; and

WHEREAS, the Uniform Shared Services and Consolidation Act, N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1 et seq., authorizes local units as defined in said Act to enter into joint agreements for the provision of governmental services; and

WHEREAS, on September 1, 2010 the parties entered into a Uniform Shared Services Agreement for a period of two years with the right of the parties to mutually agree to extend the Agreement for an additional two (2) years; and

WHEREAS, the parties mutually agreed to extend the Agreement for a period of two (2) years from September 1, 2012 to August 31, 2014; and

WHEREAS, the parties are desirous of entering into a Uniform Shared Services Agreement to continue the practices of the Authority providing potassium permanganate to the Township at the Authority's cost;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and conditions hereinafter set forth pursuant to the Authority provided by law, The Ocean County Utilities Authority and the Township of Long Beach agree as follows:

**FIRST:** Commencing on September 1, 2014, the Authority shall provide potassium permanganate for High Bar Harbor Pump Station (SPS-9).

**SECOND:** The Township agrees to reimburse the Authority for the cost of providing potassium permanganate for SPS-9.

**THIRD:** The Authority shall invoice the Township for potassium permanganate on a monthly basis at the Authority's cost.


**FOURTH:** The term of this Agreement shall be for a period of two (2) years with the right of the parties to mutually agree to extend the Agreement for an additional two (2) years. This Agreement may be terminated by either party by providing a minimum of six (6) months written notice to the other.

**FIFTH:** Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1 et seq., this Agreement shall become effective upon the adoption of the appropriate respective Resolutions by The Ocean County Utilities Authority and the Township of Long Beach.
