BETWEEN: **THE BOROUGH OF HASBROUCK HEIGHTS,**
a Municipal Corporation of the State of New Jersey

having its principal offices at

AND: **THE BOROUGH OF LITTLE FERRY,**
a Municipal Corporation of the State of New Jersey,

having its principal offices at
215-217 Liberty Street
Little Ferry, New Jersey

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1 et seq., the Shared Services Act of 2007, authorizes agreements among municipalities and other State Agencies for the provision of services to one of them that the other is empowered to provide within its own jurisdiction, and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Little Ferry seeks the use of the “911” Emergency Telephone Service presently operated by the Police Department of the Borough of Hasbrouck Heights to those seeking emergency assistance in Little Ferry,

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and promises hereinafter set forth, it is agreed as follows:

1. The Borough of Hasbrouck Heights agrees to provide to the Borough of Little Ferry “911” Emergency Telephone Service through the Hasbrouck Heights Police Department for emergency telephone calls emanating in the Borough of Little Ferry to the same extent and in the same matter as services are presently provided in the Borough of Hasbrouck Heights and further as required by and in accordance with any applicable law or regulation governing the provision of such services.

2. In consideration of such service, the Borough of Little Ferry shall pay to the Borough of Hasbrouck Heights the sum of \$8,250.00 for the year 2017. The charge for each subsequent calendar year during the term hereof shall be increased over that payable for the prior calendar year at a rate equal to the Cap Rate as established by the Division of Local Government Services of the State of New Jersey for the new year but nevertheless at a rate of no less than 2%. In the event that the law which governs the establishment of the said Cap Rate is repealed or is amended so as to materially effect the manner in which the Cap Rate is calculated, then the parties shall negotiate either, first, another substitute objective standard upon which to calculate


the annual rate of increase or, failing to do so, second, another fixed annual rate of increase agreed upon by the parties. In either event, the minimum rate of annual increase shall remain 2%. The said annual sums charged hereunder shall be payable in twelve equal monthly installments on or before the last day of each month following the month in which services are rendered or within thirty days after the presentation of a claim therefor.

3. Nothing contained herein shall be construed to grant to any officers or officials of the Borough of Little Ferry any control or direction over any personnel rendering such service by said Police Department of the Borough of Hasbrouck Heights or to obligate the Borough of Hasbrouck Heights to acquire any new or additional equipment or otherwise to incur any additional cost or expense except as it may be so obligated in relation to these services rendered within the Borough of Hasbrouck Heights.

4. This Agreement shall commence on January 1, 2017, and remain in effect until December 31, 2021, or until such service may be discontinued within the Borough of Hasbrouck Heights, if sooner. Further, each municipality reserves the right to terminate this agreement. If Borough of Little Ferry desires to terminate the agreement before the Borough of Hasbrouck Heights has introduced its current year municipal budget, the Borough of Little Ferry shall give two months written notice that it desires to terminate the agreement. If the Borough of Hasbrouck Heights has introduced the current year municipal budget, the termination date shall be December 31 of that current year.


