**SHARED SERVICE AGREEMENT BETWEEN  
THE EATONTOWN SEWERAGE AUTHORITY AND BOROUGH OF EATONTOWN  
FOR THE RENTAL OF A VACCON TRUCK**

**WHEREAS**, the Borough of Eatontown has need for the use of a Vaccon Truck to clean and service its storm water sewer systems; and

**WHEREAS**, the Eatontown Sewerage Authority is the owner of a Vaccon Truck that meets the proposed use of the Department of Public Works of the Borough of Eatontown and has operators for said truck who are experienced in its use and maintenance; and


**WHEREAS**, the Borough of Eatontown is desirous of renting the Vaccon Truck with drivers for use in the maintenance of its storm water sewer systems; and


**WHEREAS**, the Uniform Shared Services Consolidation Act N.J.S.A. 40:65A-01, et seq., authorizes local units of the State to enter into a contract with any other local unit or units for the joint provision of any service which any party to the agreement is empowered to render.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Eatontown Sewerage Authority, as follows:

1. That the Eatontown Sewerage Authority and the Borough of Eatontown shall enter into a Shared Service Agreement/Interlocal Governmental Agreement whereby the Authority will provide the Vaccon Truck, together with two operators, to the Borough for their use.
2. The terms and conditions of the Agreement shall be as follows:
  - a. Use of the vehicle is limited to five (5) days per calendar month.
  - b. The Borough shall pay \$700.00 per day to the Authority for the use of the truck.
  - c. The Borough will provide labor and materials for preventive maintenance of the vehicle. For all other repairs, the Borough will pay 50% of the total cost for repair. In addition, the Borough will pay 50% of the cost and installation of the vacuum fan when replacement is required.
  - d. The use of the truck by the Borough will be on a noninterference basis with the Authority; emergencies encountered by the Authority take priority.
  - e. The Borough will hold harmless the Authority for any damages caused by the use of the truck by the Borough.
  - f. Any dredged spoils from the storm sewers will be disposed of at the direction and cost of the Borough.
  - g. The agreement will be for a term of two years, commencing December 1, 2016 and ending December 31, 2018.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Executive Director is authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate this resolution.
