
WHEREAS, the Township Committee of the Township of Pennsville (hereinafter referred to as Committee) has determined that the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of this Township would be promoted if they entered into a joint purchasing agreement for sodium hypochlorite with the Pennsville Sewerage Authority (hereinafter referred to as Authority); and

WHEREAS, a copy of the aforesaid agreement to be executed by the parties is attached hereto and marked as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, the Committee has solicited bids for the substance in question which resulted in the low bid of JCI Jones Chemicals, with a per gallon bid in the amount of \$.78,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and members of the Township Committee of the Township of Pennsville that the Township's Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into an interlocal services agreement with the Pennsville Sewerage Authority for sale to the Authority of 30,000 gallons of sodium hypochlorite at a per gallon cost of \$.78, with the total cost not to exceed \$23,400.00, the form of which agreement is attached hereto and made a part hereof, which agreement has been prepared by the Township Solicitor.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Township will submit invoices periodically to the Authority, which invoices shall be paid upon receipt.

**INTERLOCAL SERVICES AGREEMENT
BY AND BETWEEN
THE TOWNSHIP OF PENNSVILLE AND
THE PENNSVILLE SEWERAGE AUTHORITY**

Re: Purchase of 30,000 Gallons of
Sodium Hypochlorite by the
Pensville Sewerage Authority


WHEREAS, as a result of the negotiations between the Pensville Sewerage Authority (hereinafter referred to as Authority) Superintendent and the Township's Water Department Superintendent, and in an attempt to secure the lowest bid possible, it was agreed that the Township would solicit bids for the purchase of sodium hypochlorite and that the Authority would then purchase 30,000 gallons from the Township; and

WHEREAS, as a result of the aforementioned solicitation, the Township determined that the lowest bid was submitted by JCI Jones Chemicals, with a per gallon bid of \$.78,

NOW IT IS AGREED by and between the Township of Pensville and the Pensville Sewerage Authority that the Township will sell to the Authority 30,000 gallons of sodium hypochlorite at a per gallon cost of \$.78, for a total cost not to exceed \$23,400.00.

IT IS FURTHER AGREED that the Authority will pay invoices submitted periodically by the Township upon receipt.
