

SHARED SERVICES AGREEMENT

This Agreement entered into the 2nd day of March, 2016 retroactive to January 1, 2016 between:

BOROUGH OF ROOSEVELT

Roosevelt, New Jersey 08555

WHEREAS, the Township of Millstone (Millstone) and the Borough of Roosevelt (Roosevelt) (hereinafter collectively referred to as the "Parties") wish to encourage inter-municipal cooperation and planning with regard to certified recycling coordinator services (collectively "services"); and

WHEREAS, *N.J.S.A.* 40A:65-4, as part of the Uniform Shared Services and Consolidation Act, authorizes local units to enter into an Agreement to provide or receive any service that each local unit participating in the Agreement is empowered to provide or receive within its own jurisdiction.

WHEREAS, the Parties have each duly authorized their proper officials to enter into and execute this Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE AND IT IS HEREBY AGREED by and between the Parties as follows:

1. Millstone will provide Certified Recycling Services Coordinator services to Roosevelt for a cost not to exceed \$200 annually.
2. Millstone will bill Roosevelt annually for the Recycling Services Coordinator services, which shall be paid within thirty (30) days of the receipt of said

3. The Parties recognize that the individual performing the services described in this Agreement shall be an employee of Millstone for all purposes, including salary and any applicable tenure rights.

4. A copy of this Agreement shall be open to public inspection in the offices of the Clerks of Millstone and Roosevelt immediately after passage of a resolution to become a Party to the Agreement.

5. This Agreement shall be interpreted in accordance with the rights of the Parties hereto and shall be governed by the laws of the State of New Jersey.


6. This Agreement sets forth the entire Agreement between the Parties concerning the subject matter hereof and shall not be modified or amended except by an instrument in writing signed by the Parties.

7. This Agreement shall be binding upon the Parties and their legal representatives, successors and assigns.







2. A copy of the executed Agreement shall be maintained in the Office of the Township Clerk and available for public inspection during regular business hours.



AUTHORIZING A SHARED SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH THE TOWNSHIP OF MILLSTONE FOR CERTIFIED RECYCLING COORDINATOR

WHEREAS, the Township of Millstone (Millstone) and the Borough of Roosevelt (Roosevelt) (hereinafter collectively referred to as the "Parties") wish to encourage inter-municipal cooperation and planning with regard to Certified Recycling Coordinator Services; and

WHEREAS, the "Uniform Shared Services and Consolidation Act", N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1, et seq. authorizes a municipality to contract with any public or private entity for the provision of any service which the municipality itself could provide directly; and

WHEREAS, the Parties agree that Millstone Township will provide Certified Recycling Coordinator Services to Roosevelt Borough at a cost not to exceed \$200.00 annually; and


WHEREAS, the Parties have each duly authorized their proper officials to enter into and execute this Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Roosevelt, in the County of Monmouth and State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. That the Borough of Roosevelt is hereby authorized to enter into a Shared Services Agreement with the Township of Millstone, pursuant to the "Uniform Shared Services and Consolidation Act", N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1, et seq., to provide services referenced above.
2. That the Mayor is authorized to execute and the Municipal Clerk to attest to the Agreement.
3. That the Agreement shall not become effective until such time as the governing bodies of both municipalities have duly authorized their appropriate Municipal Officials to execute and attest the attached Agreement, and the Agreement has been duly executed and attested.
4. That a certified copy of this resolution shall be provided to the Millstone Township Clerk.
