

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 7-25  
(HANDICAPPED PARKING SPACES) OF  
CHAPTER 7 (TRAFFIC) OF THE CODE OF THE  
BOROUGH OF MANASQUAN SO AS TO ESTABLISH  
TWO HANDICAPPED PARKING SPACES ON  
EAST MAIN STREET**

**ORDINANCE NO. 1824- 00**

**BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Manasquan, in the County of Monmouth and the State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. Section 7-25 (Handicapped Parking Spaces) of Chapter 7 (Traffic) of the Code of the Borough of Manasquan is amended and supplemented as follows:

| <u>Name of Street</u> | <u>Side</u> | <u>Location</u>  |
|-----------------------|-------------|--|
| East Main Street      | North       | From a point 35 feet east of the east curb line of Third Avenue to a point 20 feet east therefrom                                      |
| East Main Street      | South       | From a point 110 feet west of the west curb line of Second Avenue to a point 20 feet west therefrom (in front of 553 East Main Street) |


Section 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are repealed, but only to the extent of such inconsistency. All other parts of Chapter 7 not inconsistent herewith are ratified and confirmed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its final passage and publication as required by law.
