

ORDINANCE 98: 24

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 97-5, CHAPTER 102 OF THE
BOROUGH CODE ENTITLED "VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC"

BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Stratford, County of Camden, State of New Jersey, that Ordinance 97-5 be and is hereby amended as follows:

SECTION 01: That Section 102-6d is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 102-6d: Commercial Vehicle Exception to
Overnight Parking.

One (1) commercial vehicle of a rated capacity not exceeding one (1) ton weight and/or four (4) wheels, owned and operated by a resident on the premises, shall be permitted to be regularly parked or garaged on a residential property including the public street, provided that said vehicle is not parked in a front yard.

School buses under sixteen (16) feet in length are limited to one (1) per residential property. The school bus must be parked in the driveway to the furthest point in said driveway from the driveway apron.

SECTION 02: All Ordinances and provisions thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance shall be and are thereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 03: If any section, subsection, part, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance shall be declared invalid of judgment by any court of competent jurisdiction, such section, subsection, part sentence, clause or phrase shall be deemed to be severable from the remainder of this Ordinance.
