RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CHATHAM, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, NEW JERSEY, REGARDING PLACEMENT OF VIDEO CAMERAS ON TOWNSHIP PROPERTY

WHEREAS, the Township Committee of the Township of Chatham believes that it is appropriate to establish a “Policy Regarding the Placement of Video Cameras on Township Property in Public Places” as follows:

Policy Regarding the Placement of Video Cameras on Township Property in Public Places:

1. The placement of video cameras in public places on Township of Chatham property, including placement by third party vendors, but excluding law enforcement functions, shall be reviewed by the Township Administrator with, and approved by, the Township Public Safety Committee.
2. The placement of video cameras will be accompanied with a plainly worded but generic sign stating that the public areas may be under camera surveillance. This sign will also be reviewed and approved by the Township Public Safety Committee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Township Committee of the Township of Chatham, County of Morris, State of New Jersey as follows:

1. That the “Policy Regarding the Placement of Video Cameras on Township Property in Public Places” is hereby adopted.
2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
